Level of Commitment	Opportunity
<b>One-Time Commitments</b>	
1-4 hours	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Conduct workplace tour with an activity</li> <li>• Be a guest speaker for a career panel or fair</li> <li>• Host a skill-building workshop</li> <li>• Serve as an industry expert in a classroom lesson</li> <li>• Assist with mock interviews or resume preparation</li> <li>• Host a job shadow</li> </ul>
4-8 hours	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Lead a project-based learning activity/case study on employer problem of practice</li> <li>• Evaluate students' capstone projects</li> </ul>
2-16 hours for 1 week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Host a topic-based, skill-building "bootcamp" during February or April vacation week</li> </ul>
<b>Recurring Commitments</b>	
1-2 hours/week for multiple weeks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Conduct workplace tours with activities</li> <li>• Be a guest speaker for a career panel or fair</li> <li>• Host a skill-building workshop</li> <li>• Serve as an industry expert in a classroom lesson</li> <li>• Assist with mock interviews or resume preparation</li> <li>• Host a job shadow</li> </ul>
2 hours/3 times a year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Serve on a School Program Advisory Committee - Provide curriculum and programmatic advice to educators developing courses</li> </ul>
6-10 hours/week for 15-25 weeks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Supervise a school-year intern and/or host senior capstone internships at your worksite</li> </ul>
20-30 hours/week for 6 weeks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Supervise a summer intern</li> </ul>
30-60 hours/year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sign on as an anchor partner with pathways to develop curriculum, guest teach, provide career exploration activities, and hire summer interns</li> </ul>
